Capital Campaign Fall 2026-27

Auburn Opelika Habitat for Humanity (AOHFH) is a nonprofit, nondenominational Christian housing organization. By building with volunteer labor and offering zero-interest mortgages, we partner with low-income families to help them build equity towards a stable future. The ultimate goal of this ministry is to eliminate poverty housing and homelessness from our community. We welcome all people to work alongside prospective homeowners as we build simple, decent, affordable homes.

Habitat homes are not simply given, they are earned. We partner with local families in need to provide quality housing and help them build equity in their lives. Our qualified partner families work very hard to save a down payment, complete homeowner and financial classes, volunteer 500 sweat equity hours, and make a nonprofit mortgage payment that is recycled to build more homes. This entire process takes approximately two years.

This past year, we completed Home #78 in Opelika in partnership with the City of Opelika. We dedicated it in July 2025. We also completed Home #79 in Auburn in partnership with Auburn University Building Science and the City of Auburn. We broke ground in July 2026 for Homes #80, #81, and #82 in Opelika. This partnership will be led by Stone Martin Builders team and Trade Partners, the City of Opelika, and East Alabama Health. We will begin construction in Fall of 2026 for Home #83 in Auburn.
